

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-11-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-11-8, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED ON FEBRUARY 15, 2011, TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF FORT STREET BETWEEN EDWARD STREET AND FULTON STREET.

WHEREAS, the City of Brackettville finds it necessary to protect the health, safety, and well-being of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brackettville finds that the residents would be best served by prohibiting parking in certain areas;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Parking and standing prohibited.

“The parking, standing or stopping of any vehicle, motor vehicle, wheeled contrivance, horse, horse-drawn conveyance, animal, bicycle, motorcycle, motor scooter, automobile, truck, or transport apparatus whatsoever at any time, at any place in, at or on any public street area hereinafter designated and described, is forbidden and prohibited in the following designated area(s):

- (1) The East side of Ann Street between Edward Street and Fulton Street.
- (2) The West side of Ann Street between 201 N. Ann Street and Remote Alley
- (3) The East and West sides of North Fort Street between Edward Street and Fulton Street.

Notwithstanding anything in this Ordinance to the contrary, emergency vehicles, school buses, and school or other governmental vehicles shall be exempted from this Ordinance.”


SECTION 2. The City Administrator shall erect signs, in compliance with applicable regulations for traffic signage, on each of the streets. Such signs to be erected in a manner as to give notice to drivers of motor vehicles of the parking restrictions established by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00 for each and every offense. Each continuing day of each violation shall be deemed a separate offense for which a separate fine may be assessed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance or a caption that summarizes the purpose of this Ordinance and the penalty for violating this Ordinance shall be published as provided by Section 52.011 of the Texas Local Government Code.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption. However, no parking restriction established by this Ordinance shall be enforced on any street until: (1) a sign has been erected on such street in compliance with Section 2 of this Ordinance; and (2) publication has occurred in compliance with Section 3 of this Ordinance.
